REL 215 Islam: History, Faith, and Practice

An introduction to Islam, a religion that flowered into a world civilization. It covers the vast and dynamic range of Muslim religious life from Muhammad's time to the present. The broad survey spans the foundational texts of the Quran and prophetic traditions as well as later Islamic thought, including jurisprudence, theology, and mysticism. The course highlights modern debates within and about Islam. Topics include political Islam, religious pluralism, the limits of jihad, and the possibilities of Islamic feminism.

A&S 272 Anthropology of Mediterranean

The course offers an anthropological overview of Mediterranean cultures with an emphasis on ethnicity and race. It provides a comprehensive picture of the multi-ethnic, multi-religious Mediterranean societies from Fernand Braudel to recent critiques to understand both its unity and fragmentation. The course consists of two parts: A theoretical component (ethnicity, nationalism, race, Mediterraneanism, orientalism, colonialism); and case studies from Western-Eastern Mediterranean countries (such as Spain, Yugoslavia, Israel-Palestine, Turkey, and Cyprus).
